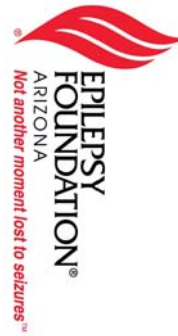
The mission of The Epilepsy Foundation of Arizona is "to ensure that people with seizures are able to participate in all life experiences; and will prevent, control and cure epilepsy through services, education, advocacy and research." Our overall objectives, therefore, focus on the 65,000 people in Arizona who have epilepsy or seizures by:

- Providing information on how to live successfully with epilepsy.
- Making available education and networking opportunities for those who have epilepsy and their families.
- Conducting professional and lay seminars on new advancements in epilepsy treatment.
- Providing a one week camping experience for children and teens with epilepsy.
- Reaching out to African-Americans, Native Americans and Latino communities, including training for medical interpreters and community health workers.
- Offering education to school nurses, other personnel and students about epilepsy. Programs include Managing Students with Seizures and the Take Charge of the Facts, an epilepsy curriculum for junior high and high school students.
- Performing an awareness campaign targeting veterans of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom who have sustained a Traumatic Brain Injury and/or have Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. Operation Outreach is a four-pronged approach to educating, advocating, assisting, and counseling the Veterans continuing to return home from Iraq and Afghanistan and their families.
