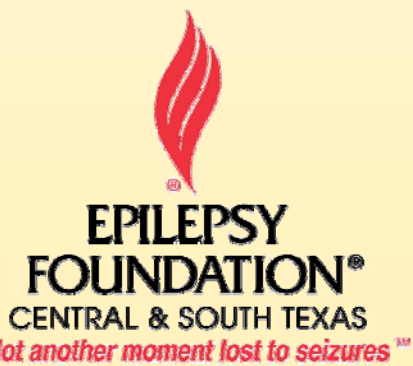

OFFICIAL RULES

1. All entry fees must be paid before fishing the tournament. All teams must register at Nolan Ryan's Waterfront Steakhouse on June 20, 2008 between 6:00-9:00 PM **OR** at the Calliham Unit Ramp on June 21, 2008 between 5:00-7:00 AM. Entry fees will also be accepted at the registration and at the lake.
2. The entry fee is \$100.00 per team. The tournament will be held regardless of weather or lake conditions. No refunds after June 13, 2008.
3. **Use Caution.** Neither Freedom Bass Club nor the Epilepsy Foundation of Central and South Texas (EFCST) is responsible for accidents.
4. A team may consist of one or two anglers. Team members must fish out of the same boat together.
5. Each angler may only use one rod at a time.
6. All fish must be caught on artificial bait only by casting. No trolling or live bait is permitted.
7. Fishing must be done from a boat. The boat must have a functioning livewell.
8. Fishing must be done at Choke Canyon Reservoir in Three Rivers, TX.
9. All State, Federal, and Local Laws must be obeyed. Launch fees are the angler's responsibility.
10. Fishing hours are from 6:00 AM to 3:00 PM Saturday, June 21, 2008. There will be **seven (7) hourly weigh-ins**: 8-9AM, 9-10AM, 10-11AM, 11-12PM, 12-1PM, 1-2PM, and 2-3PM.
11. Anglers must be in line to weigh an hourly big bass before the end of each hour. Fish may only be brought to the scales in bags provided at the weigh-in site.
12. Each team may weigh-in only one (1) fish per hour. Each team must bring their own fish to weigh-in.
13. Winning teams must be present at the awards presentation at Choke Canyon Calliham Unit to receive raffle or door prizes.
14. Fish must be measured with the mouth closed and tail in any position on a flat board. **15" minimum length.** Any team attempting to weigh in a fish under 14" will be disqualified.
15. Only Largemouth Bass, Kentucky Spotted, and Smallmouth Bass will be weighed.
16. All protests must be in writing to the tournament director by 3:30 PM.
17. All decisions of the tournament director are final.
18. All fish, with the exception of trophy-sized fish, will be retained or released by Freedom Bass Club. A 10lb or larger fish constitutes a trophy fish. All live fish will be released.
19. No iced, frozen, or pale-gilled fish will be weighed-in.
20. A penalty of 1 lb will be deducted for each dead fish weighed.
21. Paid fishing guides (on Choke Canyon) and members of their immediate families are not eligible to compete in the tournament if they have guided within the last 10 months.
22. No team shall be permitted to fish with or follow a guide.
23. Alcohol and drug use (other than prescription or OTC medicine) is forbidden during tournament hours.
24. When the big motor is in gear, a Coastguard-approved life-vest must be worn and a kill-switch must be securely fastened to the driver.
25. All winners will be subject to and must pass a polygraph test at the discretion of the tournament director.
26. No fishing within 100 yards of the live release area, within no-wake buoys, within 100 yards of the weigh-in site, or within 25 yards of another competitor. If you elect to allow one competitor to approach closer than 25 yards then you must allow all competitors the same right of way.
27. Unsportsmanlike conduct is not acceptable and is grounds for disqualification at the discretion of the tournament officials.
28. All monies will be awarded by check. Ties will be divided equally.
29. Trailering is permitted.
30. Tournament officials have the right to reject any Entry Form.
